publishing by NCERT/CBSE for the Middle Classes. The school will follow syllabus and courses as per
scheme of studies prescribed by the Board for Secondary/Sr. Secondary School Examination and changes
made therein from time to time.

3. The school must submit it's information through Online Affiliated School Information System(OASIS) as per the Board's Circular No:CBSE/Aff./4/Circular/2016, dated 10.11.2016, within 30 days from the receipt of this grant letter. Link for OASIS is available on Board's website: www.cbse.nic.in.

- The school should not start Glass IXXXIXII (as the case may be) without written approval of the Board. The Board shall not be responsible for any consequences in case class IX/X/XI/XII are started without obtaining the 42 prior approval of the Board and without following the Affiliation Byelaws.
- It is mandatory for every affiliated school to become a member in the local Sahodaya of CBSE schools.
